## 2012 Terms

- All prices are F.O.B Ham Lake, Minnesota
- Net 30 days on approved accounts
- A finance charge of 1.5% (18% APR) on past due accounts will apply
- No discounts allowed when an older order balance remains outstanding
- C.O.D. orders will be accepted
- To establish credit, complete the enclosed credit application
- MN customers will be charged the sales tax due in your area or submit a completed MN sales tax exemption certificate
- Orders are accepted subject to crop conditions and availability- we reserve the right to cancel, delay or ship early any portion of your order, because of conditions beyond our control
- Restocking charges of 25% will be charged on all canceled orders
- Price, availability and shipping charges are subject to change

## Claims

**Before you order** – Contact the Dept. of Ag in your state. Canadian growers also must check for laws prohibiting certain plants. It is your responsibility to verify this information.

**Receiving and Inspecting** – Immediately after signing for your plants inspect all boxed shipments and other products. Put the plants in a cool, or shaded area water sparingly if needed. If plants arrive frozen allow them to thaw in a cool area. Do not put them right in a warm greenhouse. If you have questions regarding the handling please contact us.

**Viability, shortages and damages:** NPN will honor our guarantee on any plants in question. Please contact us within 24 hours.

## **Claims for Credit**

Within 1 day of receipt of delivery you must make our office aware of your claim. If we are not notified within 24 hours your claim will not be honored. Our staff will acknowledge and review with you the claim. Your account will be credited, or a refund issued. Shipping of the replacement plants will be at the customers cost.

**Liability:** NPN's liability will be limited to our purchase price of the merchandise only.
